Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007 provides built-in workflow templates to automate approval, review, and archiving processes. This month's IMPACT solution is based on SharePoint's workflow capabilities. It is the automation and facilitation of the Faculty Tenure Review Process.

Faculty members at education institutions strive for tenure. The manual, paper-driven application process, however, can be very cumbersome. IMPACT Management developed the FACT system - FACulty Tenure Review Process system. With this new system, academic tenure requirements including application and accompanying supporting documents are submitted electronically for an easier and less time consuming review.
